Some changes to sponsor contributions as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> \$2000 for playing shirt exposure (up from \$1500) \$1000 for polo shirt exposure (up from \$500) \$500 for general sponsorship (name on board) – up from \$250. Club will look at direct sponsorship for club events like the Quiz night and the season launch 	<p>Action: Key people (Cam, Eamonn etc) to follow up with existing and past sponsors. Any new or potential sponsors to be sent through to Cam</p> <p>Action: Tom to follow up on signage for sponsors?</p>

8.	<p>Merchandise</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> We hope that merchandise will be available through online purchase this year, just waiting on confirmation on the rebate available via ICON.
