## 2. President's Report – Cameron McCulloch

- A year of consolidation as a Club after the Covid interruptions and the move to the new Clubrooms.
- The committee has been focused on the off field operations.
  - Capital acquisitions for the new building - \$9.9k spent over 2 years with \$3.3k this year.
  - Equipment purchases especially for all junior teams.
  - Canteen established for junior home games.
  - Liquor licence hours increased to 10pm on training and game days.
- We've now established and in some cases re-established some annual events.
  - Juniors – Xmas function and Trophy day and weekly Award vouchers.
  - Seniors – Glascott Game, Kenny's Round and Wind Up.
  - Whole – Quiz night and Country week.
- Long term sponsors locked in again for next season.
- On the field we boasted 228 members with 72 seniors and 156 in the juniors. Significantly we had 38 junior girls which is nearly a quarter of our junior numbers (24.35%).
- This translated to 5 senior teams, 1 junior girls' team, 9 junior boys team as well a Master and Junior Blasters.
- This scale means that we present as an affordable, sustainable Club with a strong future

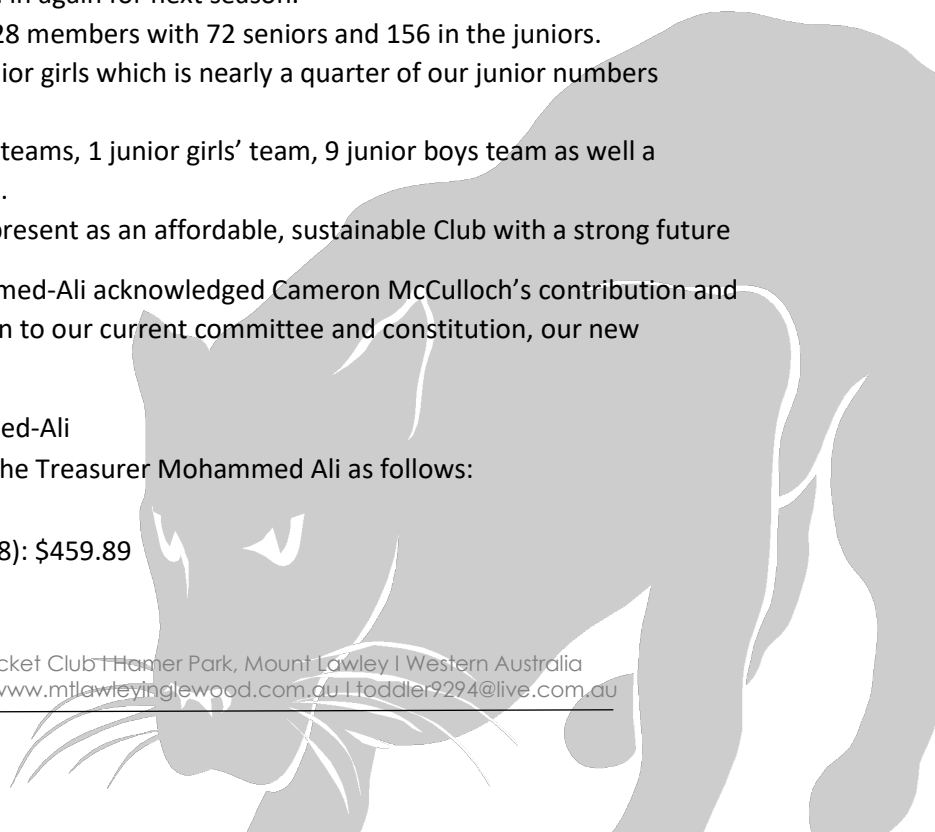
